Asia Hostel

Asia Hostel offers tourist accommodation in Tashkent, capital of Uzbekistan. It is run by Nur Kurkova, a sole trader who opened the hostel after completing her degree in Business Management.

Asia Hostel is only a short walk from the tourist attractions and restaurants in Tashkent, as well as the metro and train stations.

The price of a bed in a dormitory is 100 000 Uzbekistan som (UZS) per night. This has not changed since the hostel opened in 2024. It is a popular place to stay for travellers on a budget and those arriving late at night at the train station.

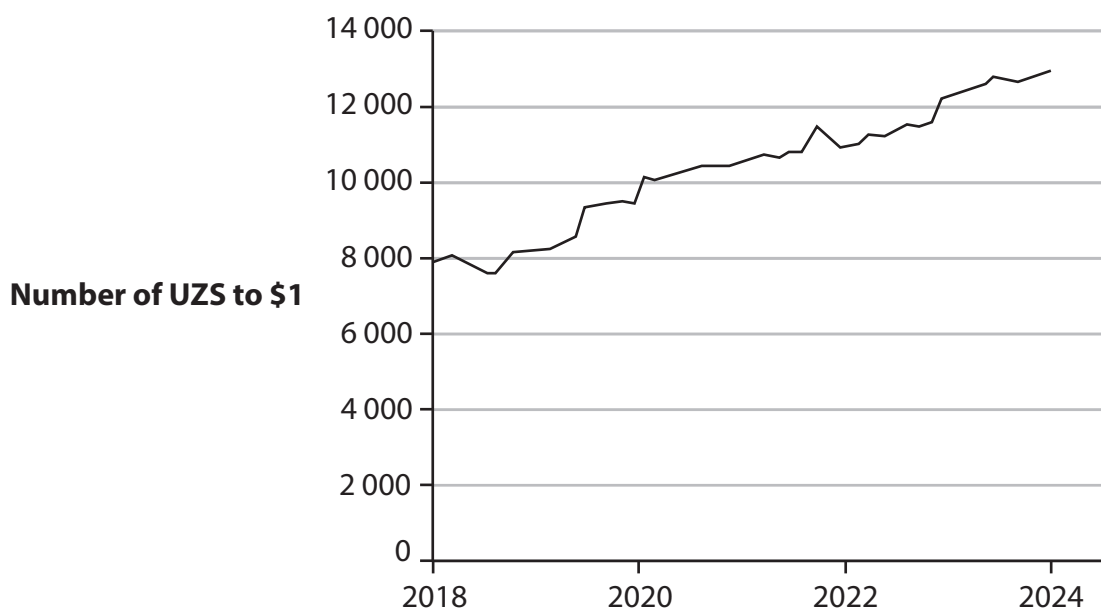
The hostel offers free tea, coffee and drinking water for all guests. However, Asia Hostel is considering charging guests a fee if they choose to use these facilities.

Snap-On Incorporated (Snap-On)

Snap-On is a designer, manufacturer and retailer of high-quality tools and equipment for professional use in the transport industry. It is a public limited company (plc) and was founded in the US-state of Wisconsin, in 1920.

In 1923, Snap-On filed for its first patent and today has more than 4,000 patents. The company manufactures and sells over 85,000 products. There have been continuous changes and improvements to the tools and equipment sold by Snap-On during the many years it has been trading. Training of sales staff on the use of each tool is always prioritised so any customer queries can easily be answered. 5

Snap-On has 13,200 employees in more than 130 countries, including office managers, designers, production workers and marketing specialists. Snap-On has its own online sales and it also has franchisees selling Snap-On tools to customers around the world. The franchisees mainly drive to the customer's place of work and make sales from their vans. The vans are fully equipped with shelving on which the tools can be displayed. 10

Extract E

What is a flight simulator?

There are currently 15 businesses located around the UK that have flight simulators. These provide the experience of flying an aircraft without actually leaving the ground. Flight simulators are frequently used to train pilots for real-world situations and for people to enjoy a virtual experience in the air.

Whether you have dreams of piloting a commercial Boeing 737 jet liner or you want to fly a World War Two Spitfire jet, there is a wide range of experiences to choose from. Purchase a voucher for yourself or as a gift. Then book the experience for an available date (usually within one year of purchase) directly with the flight-simulator business and look forward to your exciting session.

Extract F

Virtual Aerospace Limited (VA)

VA was set up in 2011 and was the market leader of flight-simulation experiences for over 10 years. It operated six simulators in three locations across the UK and had more than 40 flight instructors employed at the business. Over 50,000 customers had the chance to experience flying in a variety of planes and locations, using a simulator.

Sales reached a peak for VA in 2023. However, after a long wait to find an available date due to the high demand, some customers were then unable to take the experience due to mechanical faults with the simulators. This caused dissatisfaction for customers, especially after some had travelled considerable distances to the VA location.

More than 2,500 unused vouchers led to further delays as VA struggled to balance meeting customer demand with finding time to have the simulators maintained or repaired.
